

# Arts Education: Week of April 20 - 24, 2020

If you have not already done so, make a "Thank you" note to put in your window, on the side window of your car ... wherever you would like to hang it!

Materials: You will need ...

1. markers/crayons or whatever colours you have available at home;
2. a sheet of white paper.

How to Make:

## Step 1

Trace out your right and hands so that they make a heart shape between your thumb and index finger. If you need help, ask an adult to help trace your hands for you.



## Step 2


Print the words "Thank you!" or "We care!" in the heart in the middle. These words are meant to thank the health care people who are helping care for those sick with the Corona virus in our community.

## Step 3

Divide the page in half carefully with a squiggly line from left to right to divide the page in half. Important: do not make lines through the heart in the middle.

Make a second line from top to bottom to divide left side into thirds. Make a third line to divide the right side into thirds.

Do not draw lines through the heart. Create about 6 sections. Here, I made 8 sections.





#### Step 4

Trace out all your lines with a black colour. Be sure not to make lines through the heart in the centre. Notice how sections are made in the drawing.



#### Step 5

Choose your 1st colour. I chose purple. Colour one section at a time. Make sure not to colour sections that touch each other. They should not be next to each other, but they can meet at one point! Work through your entire drawing.



#### Step 6

Choose your 2nd colour. I chose green. Colour one section at a time. Work across your entire paper. Do not colour the heart in the middle.

#### Step 7

Choose your 3rd colour. I chose yellow. Colour the remaining sections. Do not colour the heart. Here I am finished! Hang up your picture.
