Hello Families!!!

Can you believe that it is the last week of April already?! I hope that you have been enjoying your time with your family!

* Each week please reply with a short message ie: got it, emailed received etc. Please respond even if your child is on their own program or choosing not to access assigned work. We have been instructed to record that our families are receiving communications weekly.*

Many of the children have been busy with their school work. Some of you have sent me emails with pictures of your work which is wonderful! Thank you for that! Many of you have been busy building, farming, drawing, baking and doing other kinds of learning which is fantastic! Many of you are practising on ixl and raz-kids too! Thank you for sharing!

Continue to work on the weekly assignments:

- Math - one page per day (I have attached the weekly 'blurb' in case your child has finished the last chapter)
- Journal- 4 to 8 sentences. (I have attached a picture if you would like to write about what is happening in it :)
- Reading - 15 to 30 minutes per day
- 2 or 3 Scholastic activities (this also counts for the 'reading' part)

Some of kids have been working on the raz-kids site. I really like how the children read a book and then answer some questions about it. Great for comprehension skills. That being said, I have assigned the children a reading passage on raz-kids. They can record a reading passage on the site and I am able to access it. Here are the steps:

- 1) Login to your raz-kids account
- 2) Click on the 'Flight Check' icon
- 3) Click on the reading page. It will ask you if you have time to complete this activity.
- 4) Allow microphone use, record the passage.
- 5) It will then ask you to record you retelling the story.
- 6) Then it will ask you some questions about the story.
