Take a photo for Mrs. Randall.</p>	<p>Draw an animal that lays eggs. Can you label their body parts? Write everything you know about the animal. You can write a science "all about" or create a story about the animal (like Extraordinary Egg).</p>	<p>Find a measuring cup and two different containers/cups. Estimate how many cups it will take to fill each container. Which one had more? Were you surprised? Can you find different containers that hold the same?</p>
<p>Have a picnic. Help your adult to prepare a healthy snack or meal and take it outside. Talk about what you see and hear.</p>	<p>Put a seed in a Ziploc bag. Put a little bit of water on one piece of toilet paper or cotton ball (not soaking). Tape it to your window and watch what happens. Mrs. Randall will do one on our facebook group!</p>	<p><u>Mystery Animal</u> Think of an animal that lays eggs. Can you draw or write the three clues about your animal? Send them to Mrs. Randall and we can guess your animal! If you need an animal I can give you one!</p>	<p>Can you measure how tall you are with different items (like string, spoons, cups, blocks). Which item did you need the most of?</p>
