I have scheduled a zoom meeting for 11:00 this morning. I thought I would go over a few of the math concepts for Chapter 21. This chapter introduces addition with regrouping. I have also included the written instructions from the math program for this chapter as well. Just look at the 'lesson' instructions. The other areas are touched on during calendar time etc... but feel free to add these if you like (although we haven't done shapes and solids yet as I save that for the last couple of weeks of school).

Continue to work on the weekly assignments:

- Math - one page per day (I have attached the weekly 'blurb' in case your child has finished the last chapter)
- Journal- 4 to 8 sentences.
- Reading - 15 to 30 minutes per day
- 2 or 3 Scholastic activities (this also counts for the 'reading' part)
