Weekly Letter Focus: K k Go on a letter hunt! Find 5 things in your home that begin with the letter K k Draw and label them.	Trace your hands on a piece of paper and cut them out. Use your hand to measure 3 things in your house or yard. How many hands long are they?	Create a family message board. Have your children join in choosing and writing a new positive message each day.	Can you find three different kinds of leaves. Try making a leaf rubbing. Put a paper on top of the leaf and rub with the side of a crayon. Look for patterns.
Journal about an activity that you like to do out in nature. Sound out the word and print the letters that you hear. Send your teacher a photo of your picture.	Use sticks to make some shapes. Try making a triangle, square, rectangle, etc. How many sides does a hexagon or pentagon have? Can you make a tricky shape?	Grow from a little seed into a flower with Jamie from Cosmic Kids Yoga. This might be good to do just before getting ready for bed.	Do a science experiment! Can you grow some tasty lettuce in your kitchen from food scraps? Here are the instructions .
